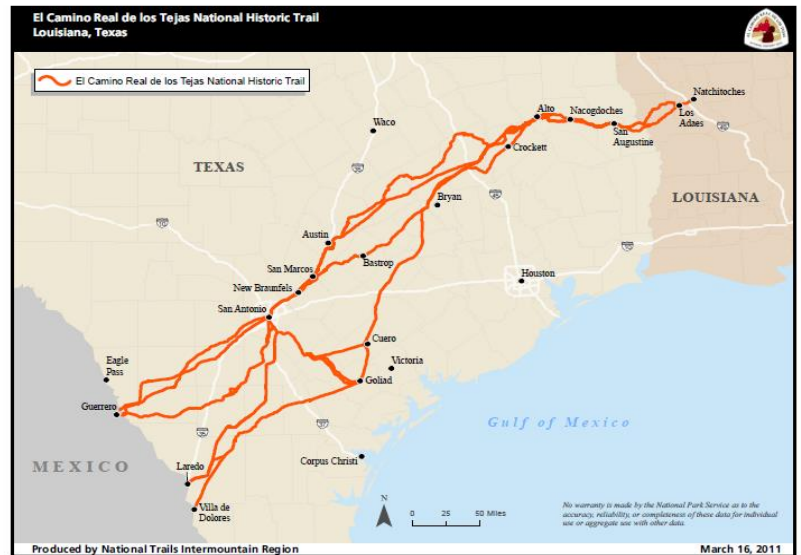




Volunteer Internship with National Historic Trail Association



Administered by the NPS, in cooperation with partners, El Camino Real is part of the National Trails System and it is in the same family of trails as the Appalachian National Scenic Trail and Trail of Tears National Historic Trail.

ElCaT is seeking one to two volunteer GIS interns for work in our office. We are looking for people who are available during the Fall and Spring semesters from six to eight hours per week.

In addition to the GIS tasks listed below, the candidate should be capable of performing general administrative work in an office setting and demonstrate aptitude for coordinating with agency partners and the general public. Experience with Excel and Adobe software is also desired.

Candidates should:

- Be self-sufficient in ArcGIS functionality
- Have experience with or be capable of learning ArcGIS Storymaps
- Have the ability to work with a geodatabase
- Have knowledge and capability to georeference historic and modern maps
- Be capable of obtaining datasets from various sources
